Oriel Davies Café is the perfect place to meet for coffee or lunch. We offer an inspired menu of traditional food, using fresh, locally obtained ingredients wherever possible. Spring is the season of promise and change. At the beginning, there are warming soups, scones and savoury specials. By the end, our own-grown salad is available and by then, the warm weather will be well under way.

## Our Café

Alice opened the Oriel Davies Café in 2003 following major refurbishment of the Gallery. This created the light and airy glass and steel extension in which the Café is located, as well as the large patio overlooking the park which is used when the weather is warm.

## Our Menu

We offer an inspired menu of freshly cooked traditional food and drinks. Favourites in the winter include warming soups and a variety of quiches, tarts and other hot dishes.

## Our Suppliers

Wherever possible we use top quality local suppliers for our dishes and ingredients. These include William Jones, the butcher in Newtown High Street and the bakery in Llandyssil. Our vegetables come from Cwn Harry or from traders in Newtown Market. From slightly further afield, but still in Wales, we stock Ty-Nant Water and Mary's Farmhouse Ice cream.

## Our Coffee

Our exclusive continental espresso blend of coffee is roasted for us by Shropshire's only roaster of beans - Aroma Coffee in Shrewsbury. It has a mellow and full-bodied taste.

## Our own Produce

Although we try and make as many dishes as we can with our own vegetables and salad in the Spring, the season, whilst it is full of promise, does not deliver much produce. There are some winter vegetables, such as swede and parsnips left but it will only be towards the end of the season that our own-grown salad becomes available.

## Our Staff

Our staff bring all sorts of culinary skills to the Café, and each have their very own speciality dishes. This is why we have such a varied menu - keep up-to-date by watching the Specials Board!

## Sustainability

The Café is dedicated to local food initiatives and protecting our planet by using sustainable resources.
