Field Work

Dave Lewis

17 April – 9 June 2010
17 Ebrill – 9 Mehefin 2010

Dave Lewis is a photographer and filmmaker who explores identity and the ways in which people feel they belong to a particular place.

Field Work is a new body of work generated through Lewis' dual role as both 'the artist as stranger' and that of the anthropologist - concerned with understanding cultural identity. In the process of gathering first-hand evidence in two particular locations - Newtown in mid Wales and Sway in the New Forest - Lewis draws parallels between these two roles, showing how they often pursue similar methods of investigation and share common aims.

The communities of Newtown and Sway are linked through Lewis' processes, which involve interviewing local residents and documenting local events such as festivals and carnivals.

Dave Lewis: Field Work is a co-commission by Autograph ABP, ArtSway and Oriol Davies Gallery.

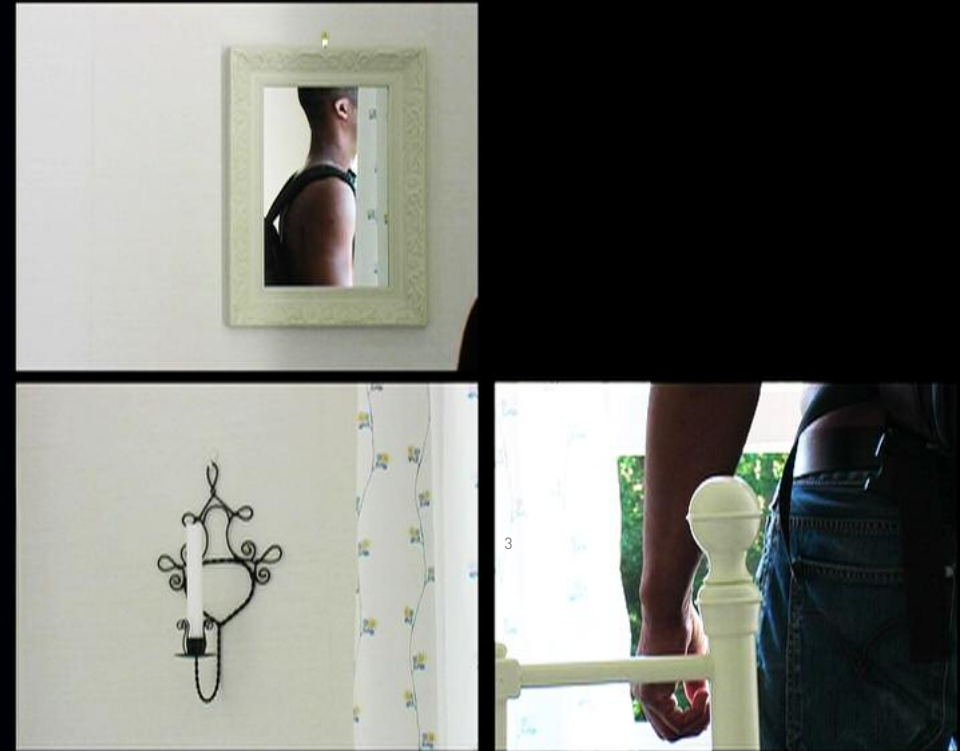

The Modes of Al-Ikseer

Harminder Singh Judge

Friday 18 June 2010, 7.30pm

(duration 45 minutes)

A free performance, but booking essential as places are limited.

The Modes of Al-Ikseer is a new performance project by Harminder Singh Judge, touring the UK during 2010. This is a stunningly visual narrative performance that hybridises live art and musical spectacle, featuring a remix of the classic Depeche Mode track *Personal Jesus* with live Dhol drumming.

The work examines the artist's fascination with contemporary pop culture and Hindu myth, taking the 'Churning of the Ocean' as a platform for the development of an original work. The artist revolves on a slowly moving aluminium platform, surrounded by a pool of milk, to bring to life the ancient Hindu story of the 'Churning of the Ocean'. This mythical story recounts how the elixir of life was created when the Devas (gods) and the Asuras (devils) allied to churn the ocean. Vasuki, the King of the Serpents, was employed as a rope and wrapped around Mount Mandaranchal in order to create the elixir. The first attempt failed, but as the mountain began to sink into the ocean, the god Vishnu appeared as a turtle supporting the mountain on his back.

The Gallery Café will be open from 6.30pm, until the start of the performance.

Mae'r gwaith yn archwilio cyfaredd yr artist â diwylliant pop cyfoes a chwedlau Hindŵaidd, gan gymryd 'Corddi'r Cefnfor' fel platform ar gyfer datblygu gwaith gwreiddiol. Mae'r artist yn troi rownd a rownd ar blatfform alwminiwm sy'n symud yn araf, wedi'i amgylchynu gan bwl o laeth, i ddod â'r stori Hindŵaidd hynafol 'Corddi'r Cefnfor' i fywyd. Mae'r stori chwedlonol hon yn dwyn i gof sut y crëwyd elicsir bywyd pan ddaeth y Devas (duwiau) a'r Asuras (diafoliaid) at ei gilydd i gorddi'r cefnfor. Cyflogwyd Vasuki, Brenin y Seirff fel rhaff, ac fe'i lapiwyd o amgylch Mynydd Mandaranchal er mwyn creu'r elicsir. Ni fu'r cais cyntaf yn llwyddiannus, ond wrth i'r mynydd ddechrau suddo i'r môr, fe wnaeth y Duw Vishnu ymddangos fel crwban, gan gefnogi'r mynydd ar ei gefn.

Bydd Caffi'r Oriol ar agor o 6.30yh, tan fydd y perfformiad yn cychwyn.

RE:animate

26 June – 18 August 2010

RE: animate, Oriel Davies' latest biennial Open exhibition is selected from artists exploring the idea and discipline of animation in its broadest and most experimental sense.

The term 'animation' derives from the Latin 'anima' meaning life, and 'animare' meaning to breathe life into. Throughout history and all over the world, the urge to employ various techniques to give the impression of moving pictures has been profound - from cave drawings, magic lanterns, flick books and thaumatropes to cel animation, stop-motion film and computer generated animation today. In this exhibition, work depicts or presents actual movement and explores the possibilities of non-narrative structures and physical objects.

This year's selection panel includes Peter McLuskie, Flip Animation Festival Organiser, Light House, Wolverhampton; Ceri Hand, Director, Ceri Hand Gallery, Liverpool; Alex Boyd, Curator, Oriel Davies Gallery and a representative from the Oriel Davies' Young Curators 2010. Prizewinners will be announced at the preview. The first prizewinners will each be offered a solo exhibition at the Gallery in summer 2011.

Newtown-based artists Patrick Farmer and Sarah Hughes work both individually and collaboratively in response to the environment to develop and enhance our awareness of it. Their placement of poetic gestures encourage the viewer to reassess their habitual relationship with familiar environmental elements. Through installation, drawing and sound, *Fantasy is a Place Where it Rains* takes the River Severn as its subject, and comments on the benefits that can be found in examining the river in more depth.

Interloper Dawn Woolley

Interloper examines the act of looking and being looked at - a central theme in Woolley's work. A photographic double replaces the artist, so that subject becomes object, forcing the viewer to question this boundary from a voyeuristic position.

Dawn Woolley's provocative approach to self-portraiture explores the relationship between 'the real' and visual representation, using traditional photographic language to question aspects of psychoanalysis, phenomenology and feminism.

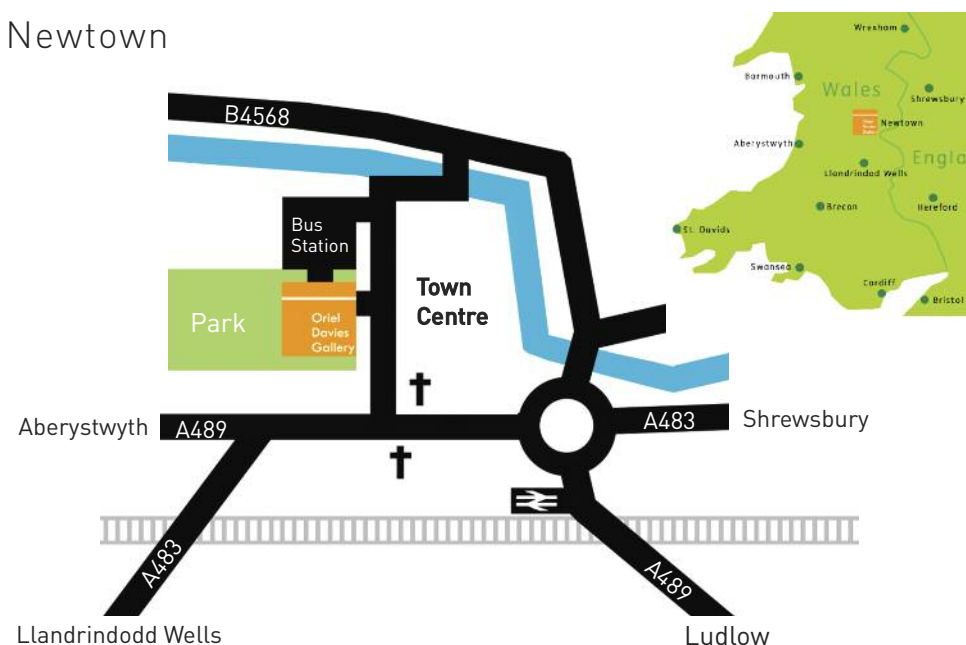
